To Whom it May Concern,

BCD, Inc. (BCD) contracted with Security Pursuit, LLC to conduct assessments on their standard Windows Server 2022 builds, Windows 11 Enterprise builds, and standard Windows server builds against the Center for Internet Security (CIS) Server Benchmarks, along with detailed vulnerability scans of the recommended environment. This included using assessment tools and inspection to verify that BCD builds were in alignment with CIS standards and additional tools to identify any vulnerabilities in the supporting environment. CIS is considered one of the most current and detailed proscriptive benchmark frameworks for server builds. It is particularly relevant to BCD's systems and services.

Utilizing the CIS benchmark, we observed that BCD has configured its Windows Server 2022 images such that all controls assessed in the CIS Critical Security Controls Benchmark version 2.0.0 are mostly compliant. Minor gaps and areas for potential for improvements were documented and have been marked for remediation by BCD. In addition, the supporting environment had no material vulnerabilities according to the Common Vulnerability Scoring System (CVSS).

BCD has taken this assessment and findings seriously and we are told they are prioritizing configuration changes to improve overall cybersecurity.
